# CHAROLAIS WORLD CONGRESS AUSTRALIA 2020

After lunch head into the sub tropical hinterland, you have the opportunity to stretch your legs at the Tamborine Mountain Botanical Gardens. We travel a little further to the south for dinner and a show at the Australian Outback Spectacular. Tonight we stay at the Hotel Grand Chancellor, Brisbane.

## Day 5: Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2020

Today our first herd visit is Palgrove Charolais. Palgrove established by the Bondfield Family is the largest herd in Australia established in 1970 and known internationally. Next is a visit to Jim & Jackie Wedge’s Ascot Charolais stud on the historical North Toolburra property. Dinner tonight is at the award winning “Rudd’s Pub” Nobby. Built in 1893 the hotel itself is quite unique and still retains the character and charm of a bygone era. The walls tell a photographic story of days gone by and memorabilia covers the walls and the ceiling. After dinner it’s a short drive to Toowoomba where we stay the night.

After lunch we drive west to the “Maranoa” district to Surat and our host, the Price Family at Moongool Charolais. After a herd visit we head into nearby Surat to the heritage Warroo Town Hall for dinner. After dinner relax on the bus to Roma where we camp for the night.

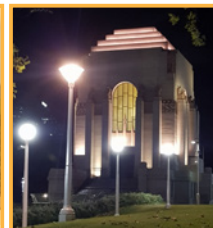


## Day 8: Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2020

Victoria – hugging the tip of Australia’s east coast, Victoria is Australia’s second smallest state covering 227,600 square kilometres- roughly the size of the British Isles. A wealth of diverse regions and attractions are packed into this compact area, dramatic coastlines and beaches, grassy plains, rolling hills, mountains and forests. Many of Victoria’s unique and varied landscapes are easily reached from Melbourne the state’s capital. The climate is temperate with weather cool to cold in Winter (June ,July, August)

Melbourne – Population 4.9 million, Australia’s second largest city, the seat of the State Government and the centre of business and administration. Melbourne is sited on the banks of the Yarra River and around the shores of Port Phillip Bay. The city has a multi cultural atmosphere, grand Victorian era buildings, parks and gardens. It is the cultural and recreational hub of the state. This is where our tour will be based.

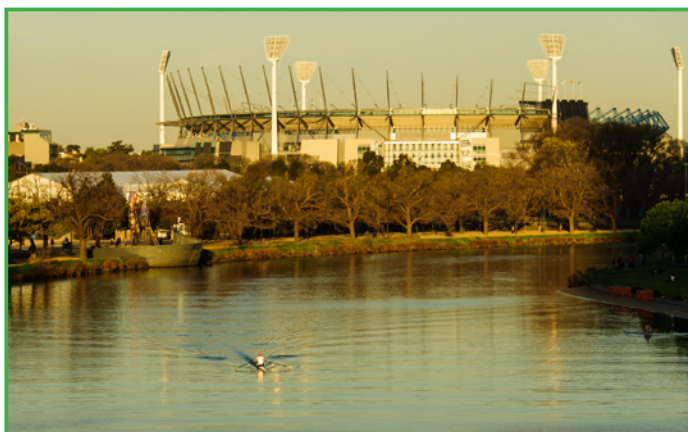

## Day 2: Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020

Morning tour to Yea, 1 hour north of Melbourne, a renowned cattle area in the rolling foothills of the Great Dividing mountain range. Visit to Webb Pastoral property and cattle display. Lunch on property. Food and drinks included. Afternoon – Healesville Sanctuary. An Australian wildlife experience with iconic Australian animals including koalas, kangaroos, platypus, dingoes, wombats, emus and more. Also view ‘Spirits of the Sky’ with majestic birds of prey and a Close up Encounter with a nominated species. Early evening – Yarra Valley - Local winery - wine tasting and Dinner included in cost. Drinks not included. Return to Melbourne after.



## Day 3: Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020

Free morning. Late morning start. Choice of activities from – Thoroughbred Horse Racing at Moonee Valley Racecourse, established 1883, a unique amphitheatre racecourse nestled in the heart of Moonee Ponds, inner Melbourne/or Australian Rules Football Match at the Melbourne Cricket Ground. The MCG as it is known, is the largest sporting stadium in the Southern Hemisphere with a capacity of 100,000 people. Australian Rules Football is a unique Australian Game, a fast paced contact sport partly based on very early forms of rugby, gaelic football and an indigenous game. Fans are passionate and attend games in their thousands. Lunch in member’s and dining rooms are included with soft drinks, beer and wines with both of these activities. Evening - Charolais Dinner Function at Il Duca, Restaurant, East Melbourne. With Charolais beef on the menu. Evening meal and refreshments, soft drinks, beer and wines included in tour costs. Accommodation – Melbourne.



## Day 4: Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2020

Leave Melbourne for the Great Ocean Road trip, a road built by returned soldiers between 1919 and 1932 as a memorial to soldiers killed in WW1, enjoy one of the world’s great coastal drives with its dramatic scenery of striking contrasts. The region has peaceful townships, golden beaches, powerful seas, giant cliffs with majestic ‘stacks’ rising from the sea as well as lush forests. Lunch included (alcoholic drinks not included) along the way at Apollo Bay – small coastal township. The area is known as ‘the shipwreck coast’, finally on to Warrnambool at the western end of the Great Ocean Road for evening meal (drinks not included) and accommodation. (Only 1 night out of Melbourne, your room is being kept at the hotel, you will only need a small overnight bag, pack warm clothes, coat, hat etc.)





### Day 5: Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020

An early start needed today as we head into the Western District of Victoria with a knowledgeable and entertaining guide to explain the history and significance of the area. Morning - visit to Anne and Jimmy Cochrane's property and feedlot, 'Cobrakillic', Hexham. Quick cuppa/coffee, morning tea. Then a visit to Mt. William Charolais, home to Rob and Victoria Abbott and family. The Barr Smith family began their connection with Charolais cattle 50 years ago with Rob's grandfather RM Barr Smith obtaining some of the first batch of Charolais semen in Australia and began the process of grading up to a purebred herd. Rob's mother Ann Cochrane (Abbott) held the first on property stud sale in 1999. Property tour including historic woolshed classified by the National Trust. Cattle display and lunch (food, soft drinks, beer, wine included). Afternoon visit to Waterford Charolais stud, at Mt Macedon, home to Deborah and Sapphire Halliday, breeders of the 2019 Supreme Cattle Exhibit Royal Melbourne Show last September, and Grand Champion Charolais Bull in 2018, stud cattle display and farm walk. Nibbles and tea/coffee available. Evening meal at Mt Macedon Hotel. (Drinks not included) Return to accommodation at the Victoria Hotel, Melbourne. This will be a long day, but should be a most interesting and enjoyable one.



### Day 6: Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2020

Free morning for a rest and for Melbourne Sights visits. Participants to make own arrangements from a suggested list. Costs of these not covered by the pre tour price. Late afternoon cruise on the river Yarra in a covered boat. Farewell dinner on board. Food, soft drinks, beer and wine included.

# POST TOUR: WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Western Australia – is a state of 2.646 million km<sup>2</sup> covering the entire western third of the country, is made up mostly of the arid Outback. The state was settled by Europeans in 1826. The state has about 2.6 million inhabitants – around 11 percent of the national total – of whom the vast majority (92 per cent) live in the south-west corner, 79 per cent of the population living in the Perth area, leaving the remainder of the state sparsely populated. The state is home to the Margaret River wine region, Kimberley and Pilbarra regions and the riverside capital, Perth.

Perth is the capital and largest city of the Australian state of Western Australia (WA). It is named after the city of Perth, Scotland and is Australia's fourth-most populous city, with a population of 2.06 million living in Greater Perth. The first areas settled were on the Swan River at Guildford, with the city's central business district and port (Fremantle) both later founded downriver. Captain James Stirling founded Perth in 1829 as the administrative centre of the Swan River Colony.
